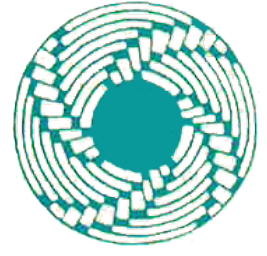

Notice to Applicants: Section 231 of the Crime Control Act of 1990, Public Law 101-647 (codified in 42 United States Code § 13041), and Section 408 of the Miscellaneous Indian Legislation, Public Law 101-630 (codified in 25 United States Code § 3207) requires a national criminal history records check as a condition of employment for positions that involve regular contact with or control over Indian children.

All positions require an AZ Fingerprint Clearance Card & ability to successfully complete a Nat'l Criminal Background Check.

Pre-School Teacher- 200-Day Position

The Teacher creates a flexible program and a class environment favorable to learning and personal growth; establishes effective rapport with students; motivates students to develop skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to provide a good foundation for upper elementary grade education in accordance with each student's ability; and establishes good relationships with parents, community and other staff members.
