Attached you will find a lesson plan and material to cover the next 2 weeks of online/at home learning. These assignments are designed to serve as a review and extra practice of skills previously learned. However, please monitor your child as they complete the assignments, and feel free to help them if needed. All work will be tracked for online assignments and hard copies will be collected the first day back to school. If you need extra help on how to help with a particular skill, youtube.com and khanacademy.com are great resources.

We will focus on the 3 main subjects which include Reading/ELA, Math, and Writing. With three 4th grade classes we understand that some work on lesson plan may have been completed in workbooks for one class and not the others so extra assignments are given to accommodate for those issues. For each day of the upcoming 2 weeks Monday-Friday (10 days total) we are expecting students to complete as much of the work in the 3 areas as time allows.
