

Login Information and Third Grade Assignment Schedule:

Students will need online access to Scholastic News, MiWrite, ThinkCentral, IXL, and Pearson

- Access **Scholastic News** online at: sn3.scholastic.com. Log in under “student”, password is “millerclass4”. Click on the assigned issue and click “open Presentation view” to access articles (green button). Select English and select article.
- Access **MiWrite at miwrite.net** Log in under same log in and password (their Blackwater computer login and password). Select your teacher’s name under Course Name. Click the “practice” icon on the top of the page. Click on the date, then click “begin writing” to complete your assignment.
