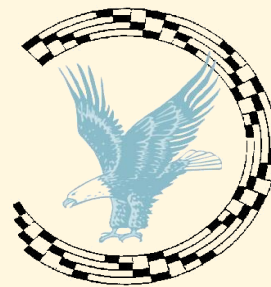

Principal's Letter

September 16, 2020

Re: Waiver of certain regulatory requirements applicable to school year 2020-2021

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Blackwater Community School is requesting a waiver from the BIE/ Assistant Secretary of the DOI due to the extraordinary circumstances of COVID-19. All Bureau of Indian Education funded schools are eligible to apply for applicable requirements. We are applying for three regulatory waivers.

Transportation Waiver - Calculation of annual bus transportation miles for day students, including transportation count week and transportation days (25 C.F.R. § 39.710)

During times of distance learning BWCS is not transporting students to and from school. However, the school is providing breakfast and lunch delivery service once per day to designated sites in the community via the bus fleet. The school delivers door to door supplemental materials and incentives to the students, bi-weekly. The school also provides on demand mobile services when requested as necessary. When on-site learning is approved, the school will follow social distancing transportation recommendation guideline which will result in fewer students per bus and additional staffing and mileage accumulations per vehicle.

Instructional Hours Waiver - Minimum number of instructional hours required in order to be considered a full-time educational program (25 C.F.R. § 39.214)

The school is requesting flexibility of the instructional hours should unforeseen additional closures occur due to the pandemic. BWCS serves students Kindergarten through Fifth grade and the FACE preschool/adult education program. The school did open virtually July 22nd. As of date, students are receiving greater than the minimal number of instructional hours required.

Instructional Program Waiver - Required field trip (25 C.F.R § 36.20(b)(4))

The school does not anticipate providing the required field trip per guidelines for safety standards during the closure due to the pandemic. Students continue to learn about the O'Otham Pee Posh culture during distance learning. The virtual learning block includes time for Social Emotional Learning, daily for all students. The SEL opportunities help enable students to function effectively in a pluralistic society.
