What If I received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) Vaccine? All individuals that received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) Vaccine two (2) months prior are eligible to receive a booster of the Moderna vaccine.

Gila River and Ak-Chin Indian Communities enrolled members and those who reside in their households (regardless of tribal affiliation), all Federally-recognized tribal members, GRIC Essential Employees and their household members, and Community Enterprise Employees and their household members.

> All children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Dose 3 Eligibility:

 Individuals between the ages of 18 and 64 with a chronic health condition (such as Diabetes, heart disease, obesity)

- 2. All individuals 65 years or older
- 3. 18 to 64 years of age where frequent institutional or occupational exposure to COVID-19
- 4. Residents of a Long-Term Care Facility or other aggregate setting
- 5. Ages 12 and over with weakened immune system
